The following documents are necessary for the application for the Graduate Program "Biodiversity, Evolution & Ecology". Please prepare your application in the **given order** as **one pdf** not exceeding a file size of **2 MB**:

- 1. Signed letter of motivation to Prof. M.C. Rillig
- 2. Statement of purpose and outline of the dissertation project (max. 3 pages)
- 3. Proposal for a supervision team with name, position and postal address (Not the supervision agreement, just a proposal. Criteria for the supervision team see below.)
- 4. list with the following data:
 - a. Name and institution of the research group in which the work is to be carried out
 - b. Funding source and funding period of the doctoral project
 - c. Official start date of the doctoral project
 - d. Date, place and country of birth
- 5. Doctorate admission of the Freie Universität Berlin, department BCP
- 6. Certificate of matriculation (opt. hand in later)

If you are accepted as a program student, you will receive a confirmation of acceptance in Dahlem Research School. Than you should complete the Supervision Agreement (see pdf) twice and send one copy to the program coordination office within 4 weeks.

Your supervision team has to consist of three people:

- The supervisor of your PhD project should be one member of the team
- Two of the three supervisors have to be full professors
- At least one of the full professors has to be a member of the Graduate Program "Biodiversity, Evolution & Ecology" (see list of research groups)
- Members of the supervision team could be extern
